About the Forum and Forum Rules

Hello future posters! Thanks for reading this 'About Us' tab. It's important everyone is on board with what this forum's about, it's purpose and general rules. The Hero Society Forum is a discussion board dedicated to all things superhero, from the latest big battles, alien invasions, newest team members on various teams, speculations about the love lives of heroes and villains alike, and general uploading of live footage content, interviews, and so on. We even host occasional confirmed AMAs with real heroes. While we do encompass the global superhero, you can tell by our name that our discussion is mostly centred around the Hero Society, which has its base called the Hero Dome located in Star City.

A few rules to get you settled and abide for, because we are tightly but fairly moderated (this allows us access to official Hero Dome interviews and information most are not privy to, so it's important we follow these):

- Bigotry of any kind - on the basis of race, sex, or even species - is not tolerated.
- Harassment of posters or heroes is unacceptable. There is a fine line between hero speculation and harassment, and we will not hesitate to bring out the banhammer when one crosses to the other.
- Yes, you can speculate on romance, attraction, and comment on new uniforms. We are, in part, a bit of a gossip rag. This is *not* the same as writing extended erotica or sexual fantasies about real life persons. Know the difference.
- No deadnaming or identity reveals. As you are no doubt aware, a number of heroes and even villains go by secret codenames to protect their real identities. Respect this. Additionally, some heroes and villains have been transformed in gender, race, and

even species as a byproduct of how they got their powers. Avoid deadnaming them on any of these bases.

- Alien threats and regular supervillains cause real damage. It's not all glitz and glamour and real lives are often at risk. When fights and battles occur, we have strict rules about posting regarding this. This includes no posting cam or photo footage of hero movements during the battle, or anything else that could compromise what they are trying to do.
- If you are a liaison to the Hero Dome, an authenticated hero or villain, or a aid or henchperson or specialist in this field, contact the mod team for proof and we will authenticate you.
- Lastly, no more threads about who would win between Flame Dancer and Lightning Lass. It is getting REAL OLD. See the superthread regarding this.

A New Hero Plants Her Feet on Verdant Ground at the Hero Dome

Today at the Hero Dome, a new and rather environmentally friendly hero is being accepted into the ranks of the Hero Society. With her natural green skin and leafy covering, not to mention her hair full of wildflowers, the plant-based superheroine now known as Gaia is aptly named! With the power to command, enlarge, and evolve plants, roots, trees, bushes, and even the pollen in the air, Gaia is no C-lister either. And this isn't even getting into the rumours that she has the power to summon swarms of bees or talk to birds and other animal life. Indeed, this new hero is taking root online as a very popular figure of discussion already, and not just because of her astounding nymph-like beauty. No, it's also because Gaia's transformation into the super-flowered being she is today was actually catalogued online by the woman herself, sharing her shocking transformation online and pleading for help.

Just three months ago, Denis Nilsbury was an ordinary thirty five year old man, living alone at his flat and indulging in his twin hobbies: superhero fandom and backyard gardening. Little could he know that these twin passions would be combined in the most outstanding way, or that he would soon become a she after being absorbed into a plant-like monstrosity that may be connected to ethereal forces (the Hero Dome is still investigating this with their resident magical department).
